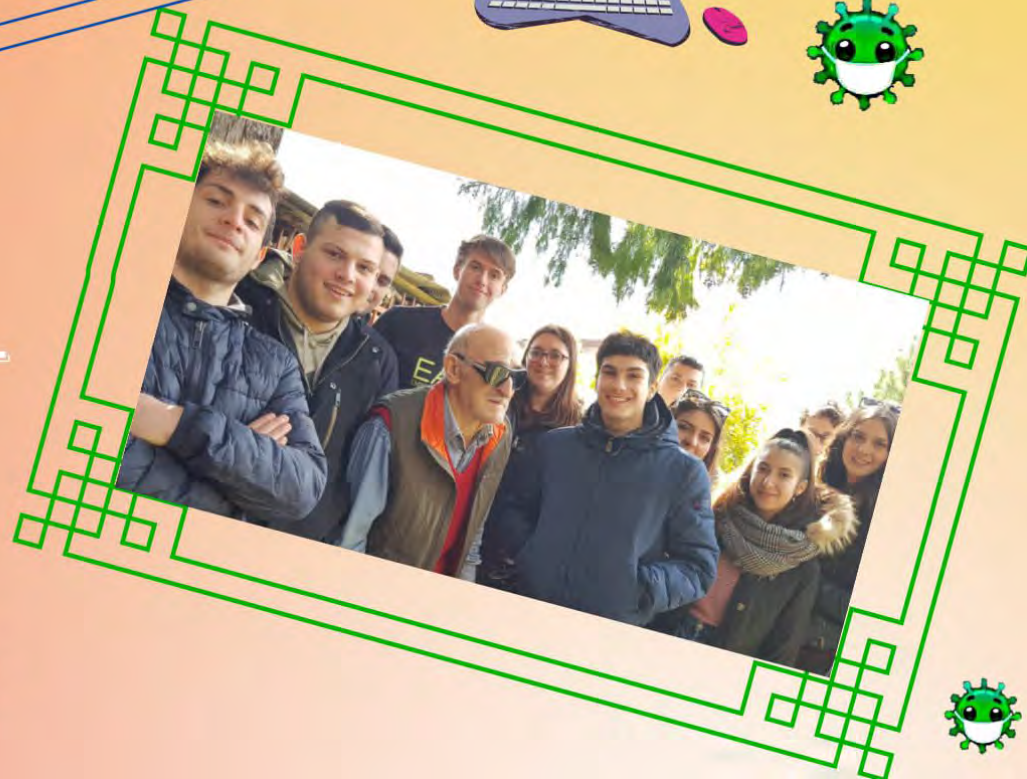

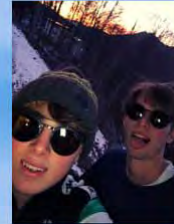

My passion has always been playing football, I have been playing since I was a child. Now I have quit this sport but this passion is always with me, because football is the nicest game in the world.



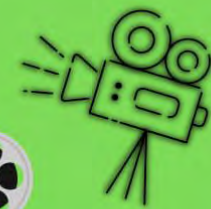

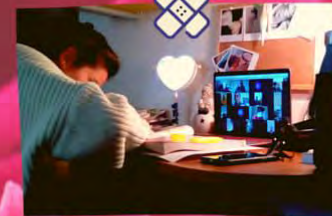

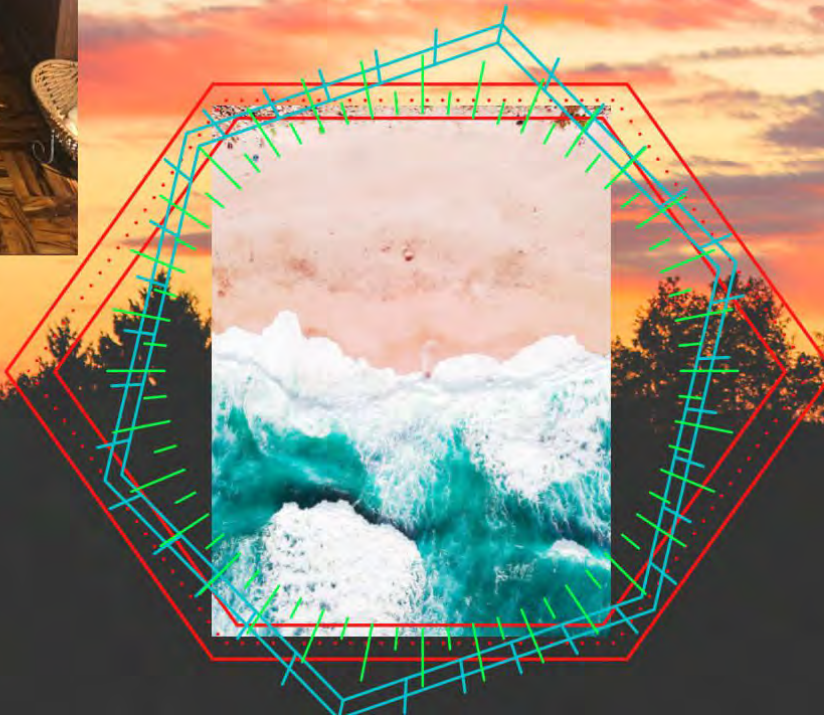


Isolation made me discover a new hobby: reading, especially detective stories, that have never bored me during this long period of segregation at home.

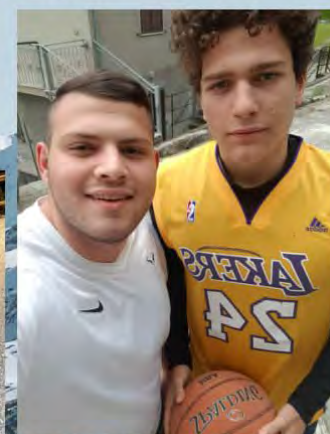

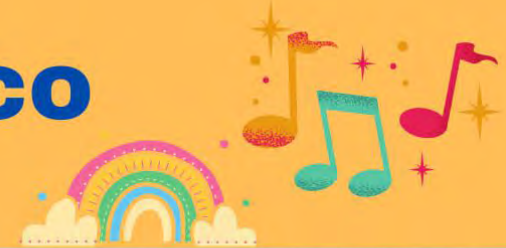

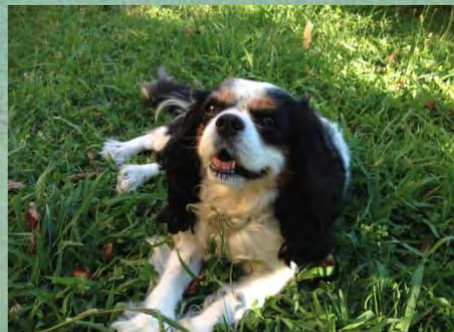
My life during COVID-19

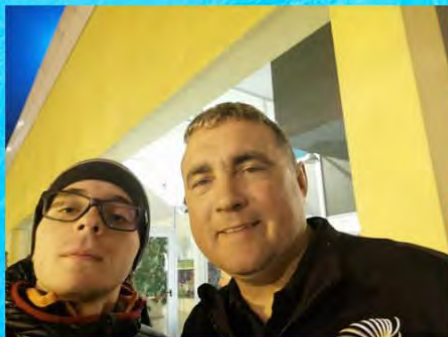
MY PASSION..

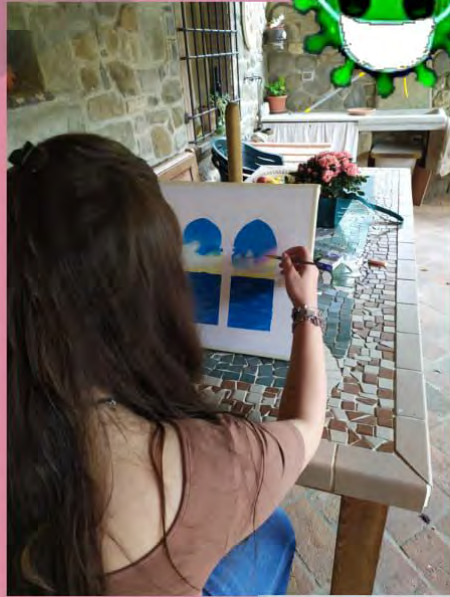

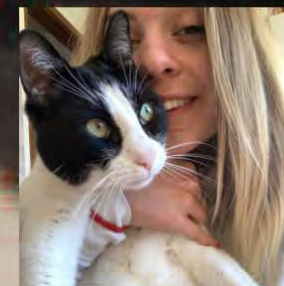


MY IMPRESSION

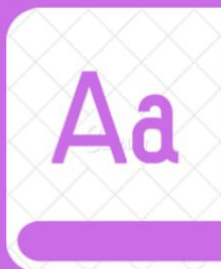

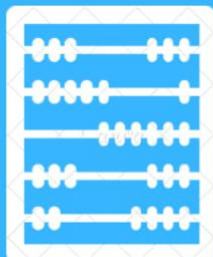
